Who We Serve

- 14,653 individuals served across 27 counties in NE and East Georgia
- 374 family caregivers served through monthly support groups
- 3,904 community members through outreach and education events

How We Help

- 126,457 meals served through Meals on Wheels, The Center for Active Living+, and the Athens Senior Hunger Coalition initiatives
- 15,591 days of caregiver respite provided by Adult Day Health
- 1,611 Ombudsman visits to residents of care facilities
- 22,814 trips provided to medical appointments, grocery stores, and social activities
- 8 job placements for adults age 55+ through the Senior Community Service Employment Program
- \$293,243 saved by Medicare eligible tax payers with GeorgiaCares benefits counseling and assistance

Who Gets it Done

- Over 1,100 volunteers giving a total of 37,084 hours of service
- 51 students serving in internships and through academic partnerships
- Community partners working with us to fulfill our mission
- 56 dedicated and caring staff members

Does it Work?

- 100% of program participants surveyed say their health has been improved or maintained due to ACCA services
- 99% of clients would recommend ACCA to a friend
- 93% say the Home and Community Based Services they receive from ACCA help them remain living in their homes
