Medicare Integrated Care

What is Integrated Care?

Integrated Care is a combination of Medicare and Medicaid services designed to assist Medicare beneficiaries with dual coverage.

Are there Integrated Care Services in Georgia?

Yes, Georgia currently provides Dual Special Needs Programs as a form of integrated care.

What are Dual Special Needs Programs (D-SNP)?

D-SNP plans are Medicare and Medicaid services that have been consolidated into Medicare Advantage Plans. In the case of dual eligible beneficiaries, Medicare will cover the majority of health-related services, and Medicaid will cover the remaining amount, including other services such as long-term care and behavioral health services.

How can beneficiaries qualify for a D-SNP Medicare Advantage Plan?

Beneficiaries who are currently enrolled in the following Medicaid programs may be eligible for a D-SNP Plan. Contact the plan for more information.

- Full Medicaid
- Qualified Medicare Beneficiary without other Medicaid (QMB only)
- QMB Plus
- Specified Low-Income Medicare Beneficiary without other Medicaid (SLMB only)
- SLMB Plus
- Qualifying Individual (QI)
- Qualified Disabled and Working Individual (QDWI)
