What is a Medicare Advantage Supplemental Benefit?

Medicare Advantage supplemental benefits are services provided by Medicare Advantage plans that are not covered by Original Medicare.

What services can Medicare Advantage Supplemental Benefits provide?

Medicare Advantage Supplemental Benefits can provide a variety of services to Medicare beneficiaries. Some of those services include:

- Vision
- Dental
- Hearing
- Fitness
- Transportation
- Over-the-counter drugs (non-prescription)
- In-home support services
- Support for caregivers of enrollees
- Therapeutic massage
- Home-based palliative care
- Adult Day Health Services
- Flex card (debit card to pay for services)
- Utility assistance (heat and/or cooling)
- Food assistance
- Meal delivery services

Do all Medicare Advantage plans offer supplemental benefits?

No, not all Medicare Advantage plans offer supplemental benefits. Some supplemental benefits are based on income and may require prior approval from your plan.
